My husband came down with spinal meningitis in December of 2014. Doctors told me that he would never move a muscle. After several years of ups and downs with his recovery, he got to the point where his legs worked good. He was walking and getting better. But his arms and hands were behind, especially his right arm.

I did some research on stem cell therapy and decided to give it a try. I was very excited to find Dr Buchanan. His staff was very knowledgeable and always professional. He got injections in both wrists in May of 2016. Unfortunately, his caregiver forgot that you were not supposed to put ice packs on the injection sight. The ice packs killed the stem cells and we had to re-inject his wrists in July of 2016.

Almost immediately, his grip got stronger in his left hand and there was some movement in his fingers in his right hand. We were very encouraged. We tested his strength to get an idea of how well he improved. At the beginning of August, he was able to squeeze 4 lbs of pressure with his left hand and nothing with his right. It didn't even register on the machine. We waited and watched. Within months, we could see his right arm and hand improving. We started feeling muscle strength in his shoulder, then at his elbow and a few weeks after that, we saw movement in his wrists. Today, 6 months after the injections, he can squeeze 21 lbs of pressure with his left hand and 3 ½ lbs with his right! And he continues to improve. We are getting a booster shot of the injections and I can't wait to see how that is going to change things for him. I am certain that he will be fully functional by summer. We attribute quite a bit of the improvement to the stem cell treatments administered by Dr Buchanan and his staff. We will keep you posted.

In August 2017 De Miller was only able to squeeze 4 pounds with his left wrist and 0 pounds with his right wrist. As of today, January 25<sup>th</sup> 2018 De Miller is able to do 21 pounds with his left wrist and 3.5 pounds with his right wrist. De Miller has received Stem Cell Injections in his left hip, bi-lateral wrists, neck, upper trap area, and bi-lateral wrists. De Miller is now able to walk 225 steps with his walker and gait belt.
